What is an ASQ?

An ASQ is a parent completed questionnaire about your child's development. It looks at your child's strengths and challenges, educates you about developmental milestones, and gathers your knowledge to learn more about your child's development. It assesses five major development areas:

- Communication
- Gross motor
- Fine motor
- Problem solving
- Personal social

ASQs are valid, reliable and recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics.
